EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Built on the same field-proven ActiveLogic software deployed in hundreds of production networks, EdgeX delivers application-aware traffic management in a compact deployment profile optimized for resource-constrained environments. Supporting deployment profiles starting at just 2 vCPUs and 3 GB of RAM, EdgeX extends shaping, filtering, subscriber-aware policy control, and application intelligence to locations where traditional infrastructure is impractical or cost prohibitive.

EdgeX is an optimized ActiveLogic deployment profile – not a separate product. It uses the same software foundation, licensing model, and operational approach trusted across existing ActiveLogic deployments.

WHY EDGEX?

For many operators, the connectivity problem is no longer the only challenge. The next challenge is delivering better user experiences while controlling the cost of bandwidth in constrained edge environments.

As hybrid LEO/GEO satellite and remote-edge architectures become more common, operators must:

- Protect real-time applications such as Teams and Zoom from contention with software updates and background traffic
- Ensure business-critical traffic is prioritized appropriately against entertainment and lower-value usage
- Reduce unnecessary consumption of expensive premium bandwidth
- Differentiate connectivity offerings and create new revenue opportunities
- Extend application-aware control closer to users, devices, and edge locations

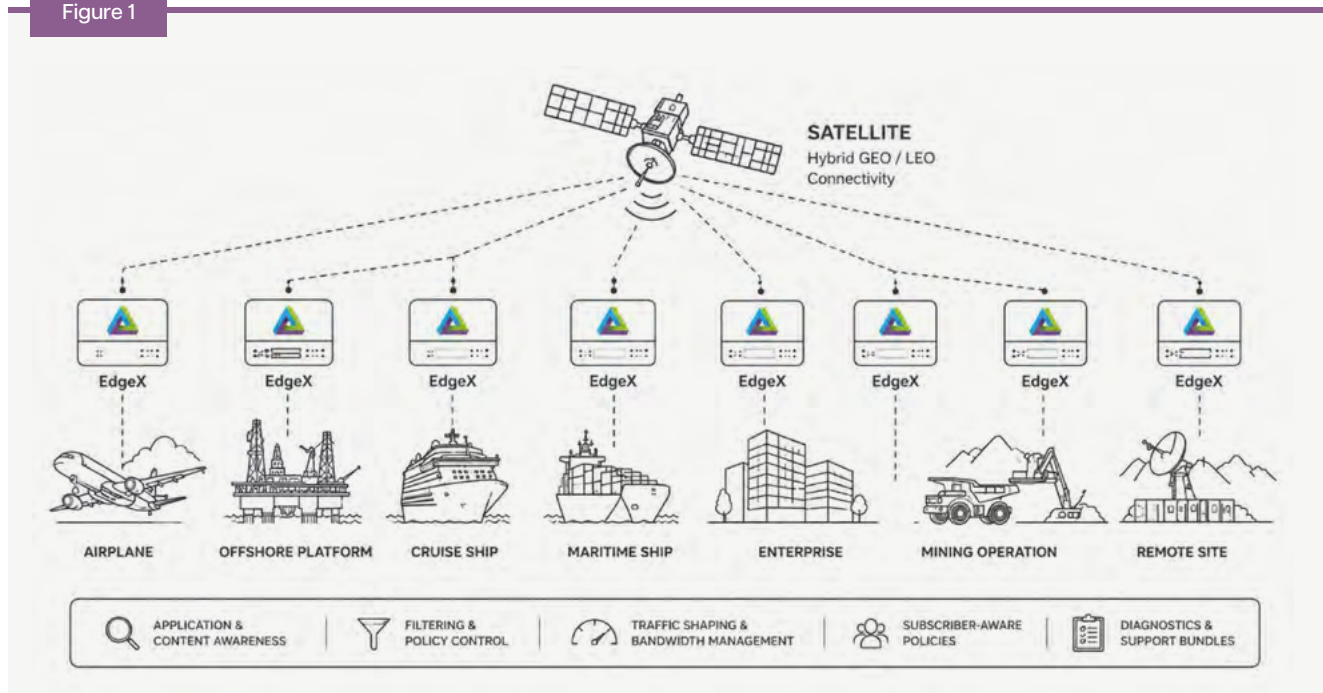
Traditional platforms are often too large or resource-intensive for these deployments. EdgeX addresses this challenge by extending ActiveLogic intelligence to compact environments where space, power, and compute resources are limited.

- Control bandwidth cost by applying shaping, filtering, and policy enforcement closer to the edge

IDEAL DEPLOYMENT ENVIRONMENTS

EdgeX is particularly well suited for:

- Commercial aviation
- Maritime transport
- Cruise lines
- Offshore platforms
- Remote enterprise
- Mining
- Government / Defense
- Satellite service providers

In general, EdgeX is designed for environments where:

- Space is constrained
- Power is limited
- Compute resources are scarce

TYPICAL DEPLOYMENT MODELS

Standalone deployment

EdgeX can be deployed as a standalone solution where a compact ActiveLogic deployment is required for local application-aware traffic management.

Edge deployment with ActiveLogic in the core

EdgeX is often most powerful when combined with ActiveLogic in the core network.

In this model:

- ActiveLogic in the core helps optimize downstream traffic before it traverses expensive transport links
- EdgeX at the edge applies local policy enforcement, upstream optimization, application visibility, and subscriber-aware control
- Together, they help maximize bandwidth efficiency while improving overall user experience



HYBRID NETWORK SUPPORT

In hybrid satellite environments, EdgeX helps enforce application-aware treatment at the edge. EdgeX can classify traffic and rewrite DSCP values so adjacent routing, transport, or network devices can make path-selection decisions based on service intent.

This allows EdgeX to support broader traffic-steering workflows without positioning it as the device that makes the routing decision itself.

COMPACT DEPLOYMENT PROFILES

ActiveLogic EdgeX introduces two compact deployment profiles:

EDGE X	RESOURCES
Profile 1	2 vCPUs, 3 GB RAM, 10 GB Storage
Profile 2	4 vCPUs, 6 GB RAM, 10 GB Storage

CORE EDGE X CAPABILITIES

- AppLogic classification for application and content awareness
- Subscriber-aware policy control through static provisioning, APIs, and integrations
- Traffic shaping and bandwidth management
- Filtering rules for policy enforcement and security
- Layer 3 traffic channels with static routing
- Auditing and configuration tracking with minimal storage requirements
- Diagnostics and support bundle generation

The 4 vCPU / 6 GB profile can support additional ActiveLogic functionality depending on deployment requirements. Final sizing should be determined based on the target use case and deployment model.
